Board Training & Update -

Board Member Lori Parks presented information on Equity and Equality.

Valerie Dupler, Coordinator of Elementary Teaching and Learning, and Sherri Alexander, Coordinator of Secondary Teaching and Learning presented information on the work of the Teaching and Learning Department. The department was reorganized this school year, and Dupler and Alexander spoke about the things that the department is working on to promote student achievement and success, including the use of common math and English/language arts curriculums K-8., social emotional learning (SEL,) steps being taken at the high school to improve the district's grade on the "Prepared for Success" Report Card marker and the district's embracing of John Hattie's research-based work on the relative effects of different influences on student achievement.
